List of Questions:

Q1. Page 7 Section 3.5 Response Layout. Letters h and i:

The Proposer needs to answer Exhibit E and in addition all Section 6.8? If yes, the answers to Section 8 should follow COMPLY / NOT COMPLY? Or the Proposer should place all information under Exhibit E which includes Section 6.8.

A. Exhibit E is a stand-alone document that is used to verify the validity of the responses in each section. The respondent should answer the individual sections in the proper section of the RFP response THEN complete and sign Exhibit E attesting to the comply/non comply status of each section.

Q2. Please confirm we can quote in USD and contract and payment could be in USD.

A. USD is acceptable

Q3. Section "8.Legal Agreements" mentions: "The MoHA will withhold from payments due to Proposer ten percent (10%) until acceptance of system by the MoHA and final payment". If this is a "Fee for Service" Model, could you please explain how the above mentioned retention will be applied?

A. If contracted service is delivered to acceptable levels and post paid, there is no need to withhold.

Q4. Will the Government of the Cayman Island take ownership of the equipment at any time of the lease program?

A. Please see question 12 on Addendum No 1.

Q5. Will this contract be guaranteed by the Ministry of Finance?

A. The contract is with the Ministry of Home Affairs which is a part of the Cayman Islands Government. There is no need for any Ministry to guarantee as it is not within the sphere of their responsibility.

Q6. Is this considered a capital project or it will be funded by the operation budget?

A. Funded from the Operational budget

Q7. Has funding been identified for this project? How long, how much, and when available?

A. Yes. How much depends on the tender submission. The government budget for the next 18 month period is still being prepared.
